Family: Paeoniaceae

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Coppertina

Family: Rosaceae



Fun Fact: In the spring Coppertina's leaves are a copper colour, which turns red in the summertime.

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Roses

Family: Rosaceae

Fun Fact: Roses are one of the oldest flowers known to humans, with fossil evidence dating back 35 million years.



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Honeysuckle

Family: Caprifoliaceae

Fun Fact: Honeysuckle flowers are known for their sweet nectar, which attracts hummingbirds & butterflies.



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Hydrangea

Family: Hydrangeaceae

Fun Fact: The colour of some hydrangea flowers can change based on soil pH. Acidic soils produce blue flowers, while more basic soils produce more pink flowers.



Cypress

Family: Cupressaceae

Fun Fact: Cypress trees can grow “knees” that stick up from the ground like little tree snorkels, helping them breathe in swampy, wet places.



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Grapes

Family: Vitaceae



Fun Fact: The Vitaceae family includes over 900 different species.

Grapes are one of the oldest domesticated crops, having been cultivated for over 8,000 years.

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Lilac

Family: Oleaceae



Fun Fact: Lilacs are known for their sweet, fragrant flowers that can fill an entire garden with aroma in the spring.

Japanese Maple

Family: Sapindeceae
